Dear Ms. Washburn:

Enclosed please find two copies of revisions for Tariff Number 4 for Rabanco LTD, d.b.a. Lynnwood Disposal and Maltby Division. This change in the tariff reflects the change in commodity credit for residential customers in Appendix A from a credit of \$1.89 to a credit of \$1.86. In the Appendix B area it is a change from a \$.44 debit to a \$1.86 credit. The multi family customers change is from a credit of \$.43 to a credit of \$.21 per yard. Enclosed are the accounting work papers. We are filing a Less than Statutory Notice request.

These changes are jointly due to the overall change in year over year commodity values and also reflect the rate impact of the implementation of RCW 81.77.185. This allows the Company to retain up to 30% of the value from the sale of the commodities received from its Customers. The proposed changes in these rates will be September 1, 2004. The Customer base will be notified via the next billing cycle.

I have also attached our Recycle and Revenue sharing plan. This plan describes our program, how we plan on tracking our progress, and how the money received will be used to increase recycling.
