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**BACKGROUND**

1        Application is hereby made to the WUTC for an Order authorizing the transfer of property under the provisions of chapter 80.12 RCW and chapter 480-143 WAC.

**INTRODUCTION**

2        Timberline Village Water Company, Inc.. is a Washington corporation formed to act as a utility service company. The H&R Waterworks, Inc. located in Tumwater, currently owns several water systems serving over 700 customers. The water systems to be transferred consist of wells, pumps, transmission mains, reservoirs, hydrants, distribution mains, meters, and appurtenances to serve the customers of the Timberline Village Water Company, Inc..

3        The water systems are currently operating under a green operating permit issued by the Washington State Department of Health and have no outstanding orders or letters directing action.

4        As a result of this sale and transfer of water system assets, H&R Waterworks, Inc. will maintain Timberline Village Water Company, Inc. water rates currently in effect and will be adopting the tariff of Timberline Village Water Company, Inc.

**METHOD OF FINANCE**

- 11 There is no purchase price for the water system assets as this sale and transfer is made on a merger basis. The merged assets will be owned pro-rata by the current members of H&R Waterworks, Inc.

**TRANSFER IS IN THE PUBLIC INTEREST**


- 12 The benefits of this acquisition of water system assets include expanded financial resources, in-house engineering, and water quality staff to provide all aspects of water system repair and operations. The owners of Timberline Village Water Company, Inc. no longer desire to own and operate public water systems. Customers were notified of the sale and transfer along with their most recent billings. The proposed tariff adoption bears an effective date of January 1, 2005. This date is to coincide with company billing periods and allows a mutually agreed closing date. For accounting purposes the bookkeeping records should be considered transferred and effective on that date.

- 13 The current staff of Timberline Village Water Company, Inc.. has been retained to continue operations and maintenance of the water systems under the leadership of H&R Waterworks, Inc.
- 14 As a result of the sale and transfer of assets, the water rates and service charges will not change. The H&R Waterworks, Inc. will adopt the full tariff of Timberline Village Water Company, Inc., without change at any rate or charge contained therein as occasioned by this transfer.

**PRAYER**

- 15 Based on the foregoing, the Applicants request approval of their application respectfully submitted this 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2005.




