RE: Request for Additional Numbering Resources

Dear Ms. Washburn:

Qwest respectfully requests Commission concurrence with regard to the issuance of additional numbering resources in Qwest's Vancouver and Seattle rate centers.

First, Qwest is requesting from NeuStar/NANPA, the Washington Number Pooling Administrator, two (2) blocks of numbers in the 360 area code, Vancouver rate center, specifically (360) 487-7 and 8 if available. Should these particular blocks not be available, any two sequential blocks will be acceptable, excluding blocks starting with 0, 1 and 9.

Second, Qwest is requesting from the Pooling Administrator, one (1) full NXX code in the 206 area code, Seattle rate center, specifically 206-500 to meet the special needs of a customer's dialing plan requirements. Should this code not be available, Qwest requests the option to find an NXX code in the 206 area code to meet the customer's special requirements.

Qwest's inventory of telephone numbers available for assignment in the Vancouver and Seattle switches is in jeopardy of not meeting the special requests of customers operating in these rate centers. Qwest submitted requests to NeuStar for additional numbering resources in the above referenced rate centers. However, the requests were denied as Qwest did not meet the months-to-exhaust or utilization threshold.

In its Second Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) allowed for a waiver of the rules when there is a demonstrated need for a large block of numbers, such as a specific customer request. *FCC*

Docket No. 99-200, Order No. 00-429, ¶186, released December 29, 2000. The FCC then delegated authority to the State Commissions to grant requests for additional numbering resources in its Third Report and Order on Numbering Resource Optimization:

. . . and we delegate authority to state commissions to hear claims that a safety valve should be applied when the NANPA or Pooling Administrator denies a specific request for numbering resources [footnote omitted]. . . . We also clarify that states may grant requests by carriers that receive a specific customer request for numbering resources that exceeds their available inventory.

We therefore clarify that states may also grant relief if a carrier demonstrates that it has received a customer request for numbering resources in a given rate center that it cannot meet with its current inventory.

FCC Docket No. 99-200, Order No. 01-362, ¶¶61 and 64, released December 28, 2001.

The FCC further stated that companies applying for a waiver of the utilization threshold must provide the Commission with the customer request and current proof of utilization in the rate center. (Customer request and proof of utilization are attached.)

Qwest respectfully requests that the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission direct NeuStar/NANPA to provide two (2) sequential blocks of numbers to Qwest in the 360 area code, Vancouver rate center, preferably (360) 487-7 and 8 should they be available. Should these particular blocks not be available, any two sequential blocks will be acceptable, excluding blocks starting with 0, 1, and 9. Further, Qwest requests NeuStar to provide one (1) full NXX code to Qwest in the 206 area code, Seattle rate center, specifically 206-500 or, in the alternative, one NXX code in the 206 area that meets the customer's specific requirements.


