This rating will become the final rating 60 days from the date indicated on a forthcoming official notice from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration headquarters in Washington, D.C.

However, if this rating improves a previous Unsatisfactory rating, it will become effective on the date of the official notice from the FMCSA headquarters.

Corrective actions must be taken for the violations (deficiencies) listed on Part B of this review. 2. Send response letter to WUTC within 15 days addressed to WUTC P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, Washington 98504-7250, Attention: Carolyn Caruso
3. If you want some drivers to use the 100 air-mile radius exemption, make sure that the drivers meet all terms of the exemption, including being released from duty no more than 12 hours from when they report for duty. Logs must be prepared if a driver does not meet the 12 hour requirement.
4. Establish a system to control drivers' hours of service. Do not dispatch drivers who don't have adequate hours available to complete assigned trips legally. Do not allow drivers to exceed the 15, 20, and 70/80-hour limits (Driving in Alaska).
5. Ensure that the persons or entities that perform preventative maintenance inspections on your equipment are abiding by agreed time or mileage intervals. Ensure that records are kept of such periodic preventative maintenance inspections. Take corrective action, if schedules are not being adhered to.
6. Keep all driver vehicle inspection reports, signed, certified, and reviewed as required on file for at least 90 days.
7. Require all drivers to prepare a written inspection report for each day a vehicle is operated. Ensure that each report is signed by the driver, certified, and reviewed if defects are reported, then kept in the vehicle for a day.
8. Establish a systematic maintenance records program for all vehicles. Maintain a complete file for each subject vehicle, recording all repair, maintenance and inspection operations performed.
9. Ensure that all vehicles are systematically repaired and maintained. Establish a complete file for each vehicle, recording all repair, maintenance and inspection operations performed.
10. Maintain all required controlled substance testing records including yearly summaries, quarterly summaries, test information, test results, records of training etc., as required by 49 CFR Parts 40 and 382 of the FMCSR .
11. Ensure that all drivers are fully and properly qualified before operating in intrastate and/or interstate commerce. Maintain a complete file as required for each driver, documenting the qualification process.
12. Review the circumstances under which a CDL is required. CDL and drug testing rules apply to both interstate and intrastate commerce.
13. Ensure that all vehicles are properly marked with your name or trade name and U.S. DOT number. If your vehicles are also periodically operating for other carriers, they must be marked with that carrier's name and U.S. DOT#.

On January 30th and 31st, 2006 I contacted Mr. Kris O'Bannon, President, and Ms. Cheryl Scarburry, Safety Operations Manager, concerning a carrier review "CR" of terminal safety records and equipment.

In addition this carrier review "CR" was performed due to a complaint that CDL drivers were not being pre-employment controlled substances tested and were smoking marijuana on the job.

On January 30th and 31st, 2006 I performed Level 5 terminal safety inspections on 5 of 18 vehicles currently owned/operated by Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. with the following results:

- 5 of 18 vehicles owned/operated were inspected
2 of 5 vehicles inspected were found with defects (40% Defect Ratio)
0 of 5 vehicles inspected were placed out-of-service

Specific defects can be seen by referencing my Uniform Driver/Vehicle Inspection Report forms #1224369 thru #1224373. CVSA stickers were affixed to 3 of 5 vehicles at time of inspection.

Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. did not have an alcohol and/or controlled substances testing program in the Year 2005 in violation of CFR 382.115(1), Failing to implement an alcohol and/or controlled substances testing program. Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. employs three Class A CDL drivers and eight Non-CDL drivers and operates 3 truck tractors and 1 solo van truck licensed over 26,001 lbs., thus requiring an alcohol and/or controlled substances testing program.

In addition, two drivers, Wesley Conner hired on 05/02/05 and Andre Lyon hired on 12/13/05 were not pre-employment controlled substance tested in violation of CFR 382.301(a), Using a driver before the motor carrier has received a negative pre-employment controlled substance test result.

While performing Level 5 terminal safety inspections, I found 2 of 5 vehicles without legal name and USDOT number displayed on both sides of vehicles in violation of CFR 390.21(b). In addition, I found 5 of 5 vehicles with the permit number CC-1809 that needs to be changed to HG-1809 in violation of WAC 480.15.560, Failed to identify vehicle with proper permit

I examined 6 of 11 driver's qualification files with the following results:

- 1 Violation of CFR 391.45(a), Using a driver not medically examined and certified.
- 1 Violation of CFR 391.51(b)(1), Failing to maintain driver's employment application in driver's qualification file.
- 2 Violations of CFR 391.51(b)(2), Failing to maintain inquiries into driver's driving record in driver's qualification file.
- 3 Violations of CFR 391.51(b)(2), Failing to maintain inquiries into driver's employment record in driver's qualification file.
- 2 Violations of CFR 391.51(b)(3), Failing to maintain road test certificate in driver's qualification file.

I examined 5 of 11 driver's hours of service records from December 1, 2005 thru December 31, 2005 with the following results:


- 186 Violations of CFR 395.8(f), Failing to require driver to prepare record of duty status in form and manner prescribed. Released from duty time was not being maintained, so on-duty time and off-duty time can not be determined.

Vehicle inspection, repair and maintenance records were examined on 5 of 18 vehicles currently owned/operated by Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. with the following results:

- 5 Violations of CFR 396.3(b)(2), Failing to have a means of indicating the nature and due date of the various inspection and maintenance operations to be performed. I found no scheduled, preventative inspection and/or maintenance being performed.
- 5 Violations of CFR 396.3(b)(3), Failing to keep a record of inspection, repairs and maintenance indicating their nature and date.
- 5 Violations of CFR 396.11(c)(2), Failing to retain vehicle inspection report for at least 3 months (90-days)
- 5 Violations of CFR 396.17(a), Using a commercial motor vehicle not periodically inspected.

This carrier review resulted in a "Conditional Safety Rating".

I discussed all violations with Mr. Kris O'Bannon, President, and Ms. Cheryl Scarburry, Safety Operations Manager, and provided considerable technical, educational assistance as well as appropriate handouts to assist with record keeping requirements.

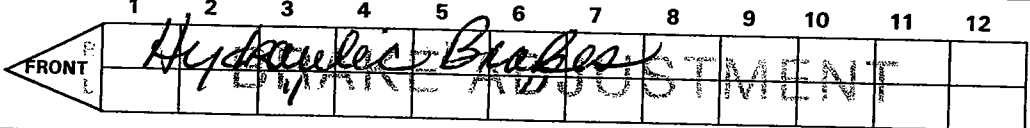

Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. did not have an alcohol and/or controlled substances testing program in the Year 2005 in violation of CFR 382.115(1), Failing to implement an alcohol and/or controlled substances testing program. Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. employs three Class A CDL drivers and eight Non-CDL drivers and operates 3 truck tractors and 1 solo van truck licensed over 26,001 lbs., thus requiring an alcohol and/or controlled substances testing program.

In addition, two drivers, Wesley Conner hired on 05/02/05 and Andre Lyon hired on 12/13/05 were not pre-employment controlled substance tested in violation of CFR 382.301(a), Using a driver before the motor carrier has received a negative pre-employment controlled substance test result.

While performing Level 5 terminal safety inspections, I found 2 of 5 vehicles without legal name and USDOT number displayed on both sides of vehicles in violation of CFR 390.21(b). In addition, I found 5 of 5 vehicles with the permit number CC-1809 that needs to be changed to HG-1809 in violation of WAC 480.15.560, Failed to identify vehicle with proper permit

number on both sides of power unit doors.

I examined 8 of 11 driver's qualification files with the following results:

- 1 Violation of CFR 391.45(a), Using a driver not medically examined and certified.
- 1 Violation of CFR 391.51(b)(1), Failing to maintain driver's employment application in driver's qualification file.
- 2 Violations of CFR 391.51(b)(2), Failing to maintain inquiries into driver's driving record in driver's qualification file.
- 3 Violations of CFR 391.51(b)(2), Failing to maintain inquiries into driver's employment record in driver's qualification file.
- 2 Violations of CFR 391.51(b)(3), Failing to maintain road test certificate in driver's qualification file.

I examined 8 of 11 driver's hours of service records from December 1, 2005 thru December 31, 2005 with the following results:

- 248 Violations of CFR 395.8(f), Failing to require driver to prepare record of duty status in form and manner prescribed. Released from duty time was not being maintained, so on-duty time and off-duty time can not be determined.

Vehicle inspection, repair and maintenance records were examined on 5 of 18 vehicles currently owned/operated by Olympic Moving & Storage, Inc. with the following results:

- 5 Violations of CFR 396.3(b)(2), Failing to have a means of indicating the nature and due date of the various inspection and maintenance operations to be performed. I found no scheduled, preventative inspection and/or maintenance being performed.
- 5 Violations of CFR 396.3(b)(3), Failing to keep a record of inspection, repairs and maintenance indicating their nature and date.
- 7 Violations of CFR 396.11(c)(2), Failing to retain vehicle inspection report for at least 3 months (90-days)
- 5 Violations of CFR 396.17(a), Using a commercial motor vehicle not periodically inspected.

This carrier review resulted in a "Conditional Safety Rating".

I discussed all violations with Mr. Kris O'Bannon, President, and Ms. Cheryl Scarburry, Safety Operations Manager, and provided considerable technical, educational assistance as well as appropriate handouts to assist with record keeping requirements.
