I am filing revised pages, No. 2 Check Sheet, No. 22, Item 100-Residential Service-Monthly Rates and No. 26, Item 105-Multi-family Service-Recycling for Tariff No. 15 on behalf of Bainbridge Disposal, Inc., G-143.

This filing proposes a residential recycling commodity credit decrease of \$.19 from previous credit of \$1.21 per customer to a credit of \$1.02. This customer credit decrease will increase the hauler's annual recycling revenue approximately \$13,584.24. This is an annual increase of approximately 3.72% in annual revenue.

This filing also proposes a multi-family recycling commodity credit increase of \$.77 from previous credit of \$.69 per customer to a credit of \$1.46. This customer credit increase will decrease the hauler's annual recycling revenue approximately \$12,261.48. This is an annual decrease of approximately 3.35% annual revenue.
