Dear Mr. Danner,

Pursuant to the provisions of RCW 80.16.020 and WAC 480-100-245, PacifiCorp, d.b.a. Pacific Power ("Company"), files one verified copy of the Addendum to the Temporary Construction Access Agreement ("Addendum") between PacifiCorp and Kern River Gas Transportation Company ("Kern River"). Kern River is an affiliate of PacifiCorp pursuant to RCW 80.16.010.

The Company provided notice of the original Temporary Construction Access Agreement on May 20, 2009. This agreement is scheduled to expire upon the earlier of the completion of the construction or August 31, 2009. Kern River requested additional time to complete construction. The Addendum allows the temporary access to expire upon the earlier of completion of construction or December 31, 2009. All other terms and conditions remain the same.

Included with this filing as Attachment A is a copy of the Addendum to the Temporary Construction Access Agreement. Also included is a notarized verification from Natalie L. Hocken, Vice President & General Counsel, Pacific Power, regarding the agreement filed herewith. The Company will provide a copy of the signature page of the Addendum after it is executed.

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ADDENDUM TO TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ACCESS AGREEMENT

This ADDENDUM TO T	EMPORARY CONSTRUCTION ACCESS AGREEMENT
("Addendum"), dated	, 2009, is by and between Rocky Mountain Power, a division
of PACIFICORP, an Oregon C	orporation (hereinafter referred to as "Rocky Mountain Power")
and Kern River Gas Transmission	

RECITALS

- A. Kern River is in the process of conducting a high-pressure hydrotest on portions of its Kern River Gas Pipeline route that are deemed highly populated "areas of consequence". Kern River intends to test the integrity of its pipeline by creating a water pressure test at approximately 2,100 in the pipeline. The intent of such a test is to ensure capability of the line to accommodate an increase in gas pressure from 1200 psi to 1333 psi. Kern river desires to enter the Property in order to facilitate its testing activities, subject to the restrictions and limitations contained herein.
- B. Rocky Mountain Power and Kern River entered into that certain Right of Entry Agreement dated May 21, 2009 (the "Agreement") which provided Kern River and its contractors with the right to enter certain properties owned by Rocky Mountain Power in Salt Lake County, Utah, for purposes more fully set forth and described in the Agreement
- C. Due to a delay in Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) permitting activities, Kern River requests a modification to the Agreement.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, for good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

1. Extension of Term. The Right of Entry granted by Rocky Mountain Power to Kern River in that certain Right of Entry Agreement dated May 21, 2009 is hereby extended, such that the Right of Entry shall expire on the earlier of the completion of the Work as defined in the Agreement or December 31, 2009.
