Chris Adams of FRA pointed out that the train horn rules require that the property owners using a private crossing within a quiet zone need to be included in the distribution of Notice of Intent. With the comment deadline quickly approaching, I want to make sure you know that the City of Vancouver is rescinding our Notice of Intent and plan to resubmit a new NOI in the near future.
