NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE

Date: April 16, 2010

South Bainbridge Water System, Inc. has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission for an increase in basic service rates. The filing is expected to generate approximately \$128,500 in additional revenue on an annual basis. If approved, the rates would become effective June 1, 2010.

This filing is designed to allow the Company to cover its costs of operation. Costs are increasing such as the cost of insurance, property tax, power costs and payroll. The increase represents approximately a 20% increase in overall revenues. The proposal is to increase the base rate and keep usage rates the same as they are today. The increase in the base rate represents approximately a 32% increase to that rate. The table set forth below sets out what the rates are today and as proposed.
