Tenino Telephone Company is filing with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to eliminate measured extended area service. This filing will directly affect you.

You currently pay \$9.00 per month plus a measured rate for any usage. This filing would take effect ninety days after approval and would require you to pay \$12.00 per month for unlimited usage in your calling between Bucoda and Tenino and calling to Olympia.

For the first six months after implementation, you will receive a \$3.00 credit on your bill. For the next six months, you will receive a \$2.00 credit on your bill. For the third six months, you will receive a \$1.00 credit on your bill. If you have any questions concerning this filing, please call the Company at 360-264-2915.

The commission has the authority to approve or not approve this filing. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on June 24, 2010. You will have an opportunity to comment in person at this meeting. If you are unable to attend the open meeting, the commission has a bridge line which enables you to participate or listen by telephone.
