**Item 100 – Residential Service – Monthly Rates (continued from previous page)**

Note 1: Customers will be charged for service requested even if fewer units are picked up on a particular trip. No credit will be given for partially filled cans. No credit will be given if customer fails to set receptacles out for collection.

Note 2: For service more frequently than weekly, multiply the above rates by the number of times per week service is required.

Note 3: The charge for an occasional extra residential bag, can, cart, unit, mini-can, or micro-mini can on a regular pickup is:

Note 4: A re-delivery fee of **\$14.80** will be assessed to cart customers whose service is discontinued for non-payment or cart customers who request re-delivery.

Note 5: In accordance with Douglas County Solid Waste Collection Fee Ordinance C.E. 94-014, the fee shown in Column 3 on page 22 will be assessed each month. This fee will expire on **March 31, 2011**.

Note 6: A re-start fee of **\$15.00** will be assessed when customers who request a temporary suspension of service for a period of less than one month is re-started upon their return.

Note 7: For those customers who do not receive garbage service add **\$1.10** to the recycling and yard waste rates shown above (C).

Note 8: Regularly scheduled yard waste customers who request an additional 96 gallon cart will be assessed a monthly fee of **\$ 3.80 (N)** for each additional cart requested.

Curbside recycling rates shown on **page 21** and **22** apply only in the following service area:

**Following is a description of the recycling program (type of containers, frequency, etc.).** The curbside collection of recyclable materials is provided on an every other week basis to all customers who sign up for this service in Douglas and Chelan County. Each customer is provided with one 96-gallon cart. The customer is requested to place newspaper, mixed waste paper, and bottles and cans separately into each bin provided. **(C)**

**Special rules related to recycling programs:**

Pick-up will be refused if cart contains trash, yard debris, or other non-acceptable contaminants. Customers may obtain a current listing of acceptable recyclables and non-acceptable items upon request.

Curbside yard waste rates shown on **page 21** and **22** apply only in the following service area: **(N)**

The urban growth areas of Chelan and Douglas counties as reflected on the attached maps denoted as Appendix D and E.

**The following is a description of the Yard Waste program (type of containers, frequency, etc).**

Yard waste service is a sign-up program that is provided on an every other week basis year round. Customers who sign up for this program will be provided with a 96-gallon cart. If additional 96-gallon carts are requested, an additional monthly fee will be charged for each cart requested (See Note 8 on page 24). Customers will be billed for service at the applicable rates year round.

**Special rules related to Yard Waste program:**

Yard waste cannot be in plastic bags. Pick-up will be refused if container contains any trash or other contaminants. Customers may obtain a current listing of acceptable yard debris upon request.
