
On August 11, 2010, Tri-M Communications, Inc. d/b/a TMC (hereafter "TMC") and 5Linx Enterprises, Inc. (hereafter "5Linx") notified the Washington Utilities & Transportation Commission ("Commission") that TMC and 5Linx had entered into a Stock Purchase Agreement pursuant to which 5Linx proposed to acquire all of the outstanding stock of TMC, and, once finalized, TMC would become a wholly owned subsidiary of 5Linx.
