- What amount of numbering resources are needed in the next 12 months? 5,000 dids
- How will the numbers be used? 3,000 will be used in the new Providence Everett Medical Center tower which will open in early January 2011. These numbers will be used for office/floor telephones, patient telephones, fax lines, alarm lines and wireless devices needed to support patient care. The remaining 2,000 will be used for further regular growth in the Providence Everett Medical Center campus.
- Does the customer currently have numbering resources? Yes
- What amount of numbering resources do we already have? 4900 at Everett Medical Center
- Are they in the same rate center? Yes
- Are they from the same service provider? Yes
- Will these resources be returned after receiving the new numbering resources? No, this request is in addition to the existing numbers in use.
- What kind of dialing pattern does the customer currently have? We currently use 5-digit internal dialing for all locations in Washington (including 9 hospitals, clinics and offices).
