Shuttle Express has already registered them with DOL. I will ask them to follow up with UTC and USDOT.

Regarding the transferred/retained authority, the difference is very subtle. Attached is a redline to make the differences more clear. I'll go back to recheck the application to make sure we got it right, but the two sections of the application that look almost the same actually should vary according to the attached redline. In plain English, Shuttle Express gets the right to serve hotels and ground transportation faculties (e.g. the train station). Evergreen retains the right to serve the cruise terminals.

I hope this helps. Let us know if you have any other questions.

Great..thank you.

Just want to follow up per our phone conversation yesterday regarding the two extra trade names. If they are using them or advertising with them, they must be registered with the Department of Licensing and our agency and included on their certificate.

Their USDOT number 1610028 will also need to be updated with the trade names. You can go to www.fmcsa.dot.gov/online-registration to update.

I also need some clarification on the application itself. When asked to "describe the proposed service", you stated the transfer language but also stated "**RETAINED in addition to all other authority in the certificate**" and then lists the **exact same language all over again**. This looks like you are trying to transfer the authority but also keep it. Please clarify.
