A. <u>Applicable</u>:

To all applicants for water service for properties not currently served, when water system capacity is available as defined by the number of connections authorized by the Washington State Department of Health, and where adequate quantity and quality are available.

B. Rate:

Facilities Charge - Southwood/Sound System Total Charge: \$8640.00

Facilities Charge - All other systems Total Charge: \$1702.00

C. <u>Conditions</u>:

- 1. Any owner, owner's agent, developer, purchaser or purchaser's agent who is a "water service applicant" shall first pay the charge set forth on this Schedule, at the time a water availability letter is provided by the utility. A "water service applicant" is a person or entity who has requested water service but has not yet become a "customer."
- 2. For the purpose of this tariff, a customer is defined as a person or entity whose property is directly connected to the water system.
- 3. The utility will own and maintain all materials involved in the provision of water service.
- 4. If a main extension is required to provide service, the terms of the main extension shall be set out in a contract between the water service applicant and the utility.
