

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO  
INTERNETWORK CALLING NAME ("ICNAM") SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 (this "Amendment") by and between Qwest Corporation ("Qwest" or "QC"), A Colorado corporation and CLEC ("CLEC"), (each identified for purposes of this Agreement in the signature blocks below and referred to separately as a "Party" or collectively as the "Parties"), hereby amends the Internetwork Calling Name Services Agreement, dated effective as of January 06, 2010, as may have been previously amended (the "Agreement").

Qwest and Customer wish to amend the Agreement by:

1. Deleting section 3. Term in its entirety and replacing it with the following:  
The term of this Agreement begins on the Effective Date and continues through December 31, 2012. In the event that at the expiration of the Agreement CLEC has any remaining Customers served under the Agreement, Qwest may immediately convert CLEC to an equivalent alternative service at market-based wholesale rates.
2. This Amendment is effective on the Effective Date; provided however, that if under applicable law, this Amendment or notice thereof must be filed with a governmental entity, including, but not limited to, a state public utility commission, this Amendment shall not become effective with respect to the jurisdiction having such requirements until such filings have occurred. At this time, only the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission has such a filing requirement. Therefore, this Amendment shall not be effective with respect to the State of Washington until it is filed with Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.
3. Counterparts and Facsimile Signatures. This Amendment may be executed by the Parties in separate counterparts, each of which, when so executed and delivered, will be an original, but all such counterparts will together constitute one and the same Amendment. Facsimile signatures will be deemed to be, and will constitute and be treated as, an original signed document or counterpart, as applicable. Qwest will provide the Agreement or any amendment thereto for execution.


VERIFIED STATEMENT OF AFFILIATED INTEREST TRANSACTION

Qwest Corporation

WAC 480-120-375 states:

Every public service company must file a verified copy, or a verified summary, if unwritten, of contracts or arrangements with affiliated interests before the effective date of the contract or arrangement. Verified copies of modifications or amendments to the contract or arrangements must be filed before the effective date of the modification or amendment. If the contract or arrangement is unwritten, then a public service company must file a verified summary of any amendment or modification. The Commission may institute an investigation and disapprove the contract or arrangement if the commission finds the public service company has failed to prove that it is reasonable and consistent with the public interest.
