Re: Review Entry and Fitness Standards for Household Goods Carriers in WAC 480-15, Docket TV-111493

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

On August 24, 2011, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Preproposal Statement of Inquiry (CR-101) to consider revising the entry and fitness standards for household goods carriers in Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15. The Commission filed the CR-101 under Docket TV-111493.

Entry standards for household goods carriers are minimal. Applicants must properly complete the application, pay the fee, and provide proof of both liability and cargo insurance. Once these steps are completed, the Commission grants a permit. The existing rules may be insufficient, perhaps granting permits to applicants that are unfit to operate, such as applicants with inadequate operating capital, inadequate equipment, or criminal histories. This rulemaking will consider the need to set standards that allow qualified companies to obtain permits and, at the same time, protect the public from unscrupulous, unsafe, or unfit household goods moving companies. Entry and fitness standards are contained in Part 2 of the household goods carrier rules (WAC 480-15-180 through WAC 480-15-450).
