Subject: Waste Management of Spokane, a division of Waste Management of Washington, Inc. (G-237); Tariff # 16

Enclosed are revised pages 2, 21, and 25 to the above-referenced tariff. The purpose of these tariff revisions is to reflect the change in the commodity credits for residential and multi-family customers receiving recycling collection services. These tariff revisions reflect an increase of the current commodity credit from \$0.73 to \$1.03 per month for residential customers and no change to the rebate of \$0.21 per yard for multi-family customers. We request that the effective date of these tariff revisions be August 1, 2012.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting work papers. Customers will be notified of the change in their commodity credit adjustment on their next regularly scheduled billing after the approval of the Commission. In addition, the county has been notified of these proposed tariff changes.
