Note 2: A gate or obstruction charge of **\$3.92** will be assessed for opening, unlocking or closing gates or moving obstructions in order to pick up solid waste.

Note 3: A lock fee of **\$3.92** will be assessed for unlocking padlocks or other locking devices on containers to perform pick up service.

Note 4: A fee of **\$22.17** per pick up will be assessed when containers with attached compactors require disconnecting or reconnecting.
