Mashell Telecom, Inc. is filing with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission ("Commission") to increase its measure service rate effective May 1, 2013, to \$14.00 a month. The existing rate is \$6.00. This is a change of \$8.00 per month. Measured service includes up to 30 local calls per month. Additional local calls are each \$0.15. We recommend that customers who currently have measured service consider switching to our basic flat-rate phone service, since it is now our most favorably priced residential service offering. If you would like to change from measured service to our flat-rate plan, please call us at 360-832-6161.

The reason for this filing is that the Federal Communications Commission has issued an Order (FCC Order No. 11-161) that requires the Company to increase its rates to the levels we have set forth in this Notice or face a corresponding reduction in universal service support. The Company does not want to raise its local rates. However, in order to continue to receive the same level of universal service support, which allows us to provide high quality service to you, we are required by the FCC to increase these rates or see a reduction in that support.

This is not something that the Company is taking lightly. However, in considering the options available to it, the Company believes it has no choice but to follow the FCC's requirement in order to continue to receive universal service support at approximately the same levels it has in the past.

The Commission has the authority to set rates that may vary from the Company's request, depending on the outcome of its investigation. Commission staff will make a recommendation to the commissioners at an open meeting in Olympia, which is scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on April 25, 2013.
