PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (Company) submits this filing in compliance with RCW 80.28.050, RCW 80.28.060, and WAC section 480-100-028.

Second Revision of Sheet No. 91.1 Schedule 91 Surcharge to Fund Low Income Bill
Assistance Program

In accordance with the Five-Year Plan for the Low-Income Bill Assistance (LIBA) program that the Commission adopted in Order 07 in docket UE-111190, the Company is proposing to increase the Schedule 91 monthly surcharge to reflect increased funding requirements. Specifically, the increased funding requirements for LIBA in this filing are for the increase in agency compensation per client qualified and for the number of program participants, as set forth in the Five-Year Plan. The Company respectfully requests an effective date of June 20, 2013.

This price change will result in an overall average increase to Washington customers of approximately 0.04 percent. For residential customers, the fixed monthly surcharge will increase by \$0.05 per month. For the average residential customer using 1,300 kWh per month, the proposed change to Schedule 91 will result in a monthly bill increase of 0.05 percent.
