Please find attached revised tariff pages related revisions for G-60 Tariff Number 27 for Fiorito Enterprises, Inc & Rabanco Companies (dba Kent-Meridian Disposal Company, Republic Services of Kent). This revision is necessary to correct a clerical error in the tariff pages (recently approved TG-131164). The Multifamily Commodity credit was shown as a debit of \$0.19 per yard when it should have been a credit to customers of \$0.19 (a price decrease) as reflected in the accounting work papers submitted to and reviewed by the WUTC. We are asking that this rate become effective on August 15, 2013 so customers recognize the benefit of the credit in their August bills.
