Attached is Tariff No. 15 to be effective December 1, 2013, which cancels Tariff No. 14, for Waste Control, Inc. ("WCI").

We request a docket for the October 30, 2013 meeting. Our billing date for Cowlitz County customers is November 20, 2013 for services rendered in December 2013 and January 2014. (Our pre-billing schedule for two months has been previously approved by the Commission.)

The tariff includes rates for unincorporated areas in portions of the counties of Cowlitz, Clark and Skamania. The portion of Skamania is solely for the inclusion of the Mt. Saint Helens area.

Waste Control Inc.'s last general rate increase was effective February 1, 2010. Over the last 4 years many cost increases have occurred. The most significant of which is the increase in landfill costs in Cowlitz County. The Cowlitz County Commissioners decided to increase the fees for dumping in the Cowlitz County Transfer Station by 31%. It is, therefore, necessary to increase rates to our customers to cover our ever increasing cost of providing service.

The Lurito-Gallagher formula provides an available increase in revenues of approximately \$386,000. The enclosed price out analysis shows revenue generation projected for the rates requested to be nearly \$392,000. This represents an overall increase in revenues, without pass-through revenues, of 11.4%.

As required by Commission rules, a copy of this transmittal letter will be mailed to the County Councils and to the Mayors of all cities impacted by this filing. We will be mailing notices to all affected customers on or before September 30, 2013. We will file a copy of the customer notices with your office at the same time.

My authority to file on behalf of Waste Control, Inc. is on file with the Commission.

The Company hereby petitions under WAC 480-07-051 for an exemption to the work paper filing requirements outlined in WAC 480-07-520(4)(j). The Company is providing information about every transaction with an affiliated interest or subsidiary, including a full description of the relationship, the length of time the relationship has been ongoing, and the terms and amounts of transactions. The Waste Control Companies are owned by the same individuals, but not by any parent entity. Waste Control, Inc. is not required to file an annual Affiliated Interest Report due to its size. We did not compile financial statements as of June 30, 2013 for all the affiliated companies. To do so would have been a financial hardship for WCI and would have been cost that would be passed on to its customers and therefore requests an exemption from this requirement.



NOTICE OF PROPOSED RATE INCREASE

To Our Valued Customers:

Thank you for your support of our solid waste services. We work hard to provide superior service at the lowest possible price.

Our last rate increase took effect on January 1, 2010. Since then, costs have continued to increase as expected over these last nearly four years. Fuel, labor, medical insurance and new equipment costs reflect the largest increases to date. However, Cowlitz County has informed us that beginning December 1, 2013 our solid waste disposal rate will increase 31% from \$37.30 to \$49.00 per ton. This increase, along with nearly four years of cost increases, forced us to file a request with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (the commission) to increase our rates.

The commission has the authority to set final rates that may vary from our company's request, depending on the results of its investigation. 
