To Whom It May Concern:

Veneer Chip transport, Inc. (VCT) is requesting temporary 30 day Authority to engage in operation while we apply for Permanent Authority.

Veneer Chip is requesting this authority to haul refuse material from a Commercial recycling facility located within the city of Seattle to Weyerhaeuser Merf in Longview, WA, Weyerhaeuser landfill in Castle Orck, WA as well as contracted hauls for Waste Management (WM) hauling for their transfer stations in Cle-Elum and Ellensburg.

Without proper education VCT has been hauling refuse for DRS. We have an immediate need to be granted temporary authority to continue these hauls and not disrupt the flow of material or our customer.

VCT has been in business for 60 years in the northwest transporting wood residuals and recyclables. Recently invited to haul under contract for WM and others as a growth to our already stable business. Our company strives for safety with managers as board members of the WTA Safety Management Council.

We are confident in our hauls as our customers have exhausted all known options for haulers prior to requesting our services. We are new to this and would like the opportunity to get compliant by way of temporary authority while we apply for Permanent Authority under your jurisdiction.
