BACKGROUND

- 1 On April 23, 2015, Operator Service Company, LLC (Operator Service or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition for an extension of time to file its annual report for 2014 as required by [WAC 480-120-382](#). According to Operator Service, it is unable to prepare the report due to year-end financial statements that will not be finalized and approved by the due date. Operator Service seeks an extension until July 1, 2015. The Company understands that the annual regulatory fee must be filed and paid on or before May 1, 2015.

- 2 Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommends granting Operator Service’s request for exemption.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 3 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate public service companies, including competitively classified telecommunications companies. [RCW 80.01.040](#), [RCW 80.04](#) and [RCW 80.36](#).

- 4 (2) Operator Service is a competitively classified telecommunications company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.

- 5 (3) Operator Service is subject to [WAC 480-120-382](#), which requires competitively
classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report no later than
May 1 of each year.
- 6 (4) Under [WAC 480-120-015](#), the Commission may grant an exemption from any
rule in [WAC 480-120](#), if consistent with the public interest, the purposes
underlying regulation and applicable statutes. See also [WAC 480-07-110](#).
- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on
April 30, 2015.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition in Docket UT-150657 by Operator Service filed on
April 23, 2015, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the
exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying
the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The request by Operator Service Company, LLC for an exemption from [WAC](#)
[480-120-382](#) and for an extension until July 1, 2015, to file its 2014 annual report
is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Operator Service Company, LLC to file its annual report by July 1,
2015, may result in the Commission invoking [RCW 80.04.405](#), which allows the
Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission
orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Operator Service
Company, LLC to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
