ORDER GRANTING EXEMPTION
FROM RULE; GRANTING COMPANY
ADDITIONAL TIME TO FILE
ANNUAL REPORT

BACKGROUND

- 1 On March 16, 2016, Global Connection Inc. of America (Global Connection or Company) filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a petition for an extension of time to file its annual report for 2015 as required by WAC 480-120-382. According to Global Connection, it is unable to prepare the report due to year-end financial statements that will not be finalized and approved by the due date. Global Connection seeks an extension until July 1, 2016. The Company understands that the annual regulatory fee must be paid on or before May 1, 2016.
- 2 Commission Staff reviewed the request and recommends granting Global Connection's request for exemption.

FINDINGS AND CONCLUSIONS

- 3 (1) The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission is an agency of the State of Washington vested by statute with the authority to regulate public service companies, including competitively classified telecommunications companies. RCW 80.01.040, RCW 80.04, and RCW 80.36.
- 4 (2) Global Connection is a competitively classified telecommunications company and a public service company subject to Commission jurisdiction.
- 5 (3) Global Connection is subject to WAC 480-120-382, which requires competitively classified telecommunications companies to file an annual report no later than May 1 of each year.

- 6 (4) Under WAC 480-120-015, the Commission may grant an exemption from any rule
in WAC 480-120, if consistent with the public interest, the purposes underlying
regulation and applicable statutes. See also WAC 480-07-110.
- 7 (5) This matter came before the Commission at its regularly scheduled meeting on
April 7, 2016.
- 8 (6) After review of the petition in Docket UT-160307 by Global Connection filed on
March 16, 2016, and giving due consideration, the Commission finds that the
exemption is in the public interest and is consistent with the purposes underlying
the regulation and applicable statutes and should be granted.

O R D E R

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:

- 9 (1) The request by Global Connection Inc. of America for an exemption from WAC
480-120-382 and for an extension until July 1, 2016, to file its 2015 annual report
is granted.
- 10 (2) Failure by Global Connection Inc. of America to file its annual report by July 1,
2016, may result in the Commission invoking RCW 80.04.405, which allows the
Commission to assess penalties for violations of statute, rules and Commission
orders.
- 11 (3) The Commission retains jurisdiction over the subject matter and Global
Connection Inc. of America to effectuate the provisions of this Order.

The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public
interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
