On 05/14/2016 at 2337 hours, I was dispatched to the area of Division and Sprague to the BNSF Railway crossing overpassing on a report of a train vs. pedestrian. The train crew told dispatch a pedestrian was "Gone". No other information was available at the time.

Officer Mohondro and I responded to Division and Sprague to check the area for the pedestrian. I located the male who was later identified as Benjamin Oien by his WA State Identification card. Oien's body was laying under the train on the southernmost set of tracks, on the over pass.

It was immediately evident that life saving measure would not be possible. I advised radio to send in one medic who pronounced Oien deceased at 2346 hours. I was able to see Oien's body was cut in half by one of the train wheels.

I contacted the train engineer, Kyle Appel and he told me the following:

Appel said he was traveling E/B on the south tracks going over the Division Street over pass. Appel said he saw a male lying face down with his chest across the north rail. Appel said as the train approached Oien did not move. He said Oien's head was facing N/B and it appeared he had a hoodie pulled over his head. Appel said the train he was driving was #7988 East.

I spoke with the train conductor Eric Smith and he said he never saw the male laying on the tracks. Smith did mention that he heard it.

Major crimes Detective Barrington responded to the scene along with Sgt. McNab.

I started a crime scene log and turned it over to Detective Barrington.

Corporal Spiering responded and took photographs of the scene.

The medical examiner also responded and took possession of Oien's body.

Barrington collected a backpack that was found near Oien that had some personal belongings inside it. I transported the backpack to SPD Property and booked it on as safekeeping.

On 05-14-16 at 2337 hours, I went with other Officers to the Railroad overpass at Division/Sprague on the report of a Train vs Pedestrian accident. The comp was a dispatcher from BNSF. They were calling on behalf of one of their Train Crews who had contacted them via radio. The crew advised they had hit a pedestrian and he was "gone".

Ofc Thompson located a body on the tracks under a stopped train. It was located on the train tracks between Division and Pine just North of Sprague. There are three sets of tracks. The body was on the furthest South set of tracks. There were trains stopped on the South and middle tracks. The furthest North track was empty.

I arrived on scene and saw the victim's lower half body in between the tracks under the train. His upper body was in between tracks one and two. The upper body was face down. There was a back pack near the upper body just to the East. I noticed a black baseball bat just to the West of the body. The bat was stuck under one of the tracks. I did not know if it was related. Lt McCabe was also on scene. He notified Sgt McNab of Major Crimes and the Command staff.

I remained on scene until Sgt McNab and Det. Barrington arrived. I briefed them and confirmed they did not need any more Patrol Resources.

On 05/14/16 at about 1336 hours, I responded to the railroad tracks near Sprague/Pine regarding a male that had been struck by the train. I entered the crime scene, and photographed it to include the victim and other items. Those items included a green corded earbud set, single green earpiece, backpack, as well as both portions of the victim's body. Since the train had been travelling from west to east at the time it struck the victim, and the corded earbuds were the first item from the west, I lay a tape measure along the south rail with the starting point being the corded earbud. I photographed each item and its measurement as well. the measurements are as follows, from west to east:

- Corded Earbuds 0'0"
- Start of blood trail 14'10"
- single green earbud 18'9"
- Victim upper torso 22'
- victim lower torso (waist) 25'
- backpack 27'10"
- victim lower torso (feet) 29'5"

On 07/19/2016 I received the autopsy report on Benjamin S Oien. The report was completed by Dr. Sally Aiken with the Spokane County Medical Examiner's Office. According to Dr. Sally Aiken Oien's death was attributed to transection of the body between the chest and abdomen due to crushing force and the manner of death was determined to be suicide.

Based on Dr. Sally Aiken's findings and the investigation to date it is recommended that this case be settled at this time.

On 05/15/2016, at 2352 hours, I received a telephone call from Sgt M McNab, during which time I was requested to respond to the area of Sprague, between Division and Pine, reference a Burlington Northern Train vs Pedestrian Accident. I did respond as requested and at approximately 0027 hours on 05/16/2016 I did arrive on scene. Upon arrival Cpl. Nate Spiering was taking photographs of the train tracks located south of Sprague, at Pine.

I then contacted Sgt M McNab who was up along the train tracks with Officer G Thompson, Sgt R Tilley, BNSF Police Officer Pete Seymour, BNSF Claims Representative Josh Gore, and other members of BNSF. Upon arrival I was briefed about the incident. The engineer, Kyle Appel, was traveling eastbound in the south train track from Division when he observed a subject laying over the northern rail of the southern tracks. The individual was lying face down over the rail. Appel attempted to stop the train however he was unable to stop prior to striking the individual laying over the rail. Once the train was stopped a deceased male, whose body had been severed into two pieces was discovered under the box cars.

On 05/16/2016, at approximately 0035 hours, Sgt M McNab notified the Medical Examiner's Office Investigator, Jim Uttke.

I then entered the scene at approximately 0037 hours. Sgt R Tilley escorted me to the north side of the south track. I observed the deceased, a white male's upper torso, lying face down, just outside the north rail of the southern track. The upper torso was face down.

I observed that the lower torso was lying underneath the train, in the middle of the south track, just east of the upper torso (several feet). I observed that the male was wearing a black North Central Indians hooded sweatshirt, with the hood pulled up over his head and black gloves.

Lying near the upper torso, just east of this portion of the deceased was a small back pack. The contents of the back pack were searched and other than miscellaneous items a syringe, wrapped in a plastic grocery sack was located in the back pack.

I observed that the lower body had on black jeans with a gray belt and blue/white high top tennis shoes. I observed an Altoids container lying just at the hip line of the lower body, near the pants pocket. The container was later determined to contain miscellaneous cigarette papers.

Based on the blood staining along the north rail the impact with the train and the deceased male appeared to have occurred just a few feet west of the location of the upper torso. The blood ran along the north rail, towards the direction of the lower body. I did observe some body matter/tissue along the north rail, between the suspected impact and the upper torso. Also, underneath the tracks near the suspected impact I observed what appeared to be a pair of ear buds lying under the train.

On 05/16/2016, at approximately 0106 hours, ME Investigator Jim Uttke arrived on scene. At that time we then examined the deceased. Upon examining the upper torso I noted that the deceased was wearing a red bandana which appeared to be wrapped around his neck. The deceased also had a black head wrap wrapped around his eyes, covering his upper forehead area down to the bridge of his nose. Also, lying near the suspected point of impact, approximately 19 feet, east of the main earbuds, there appeared to be a green electronic piece, similar in color to the ear buds.

Upon further inspection of the upper body I did note a tear drop tattoo below the left eye and on the upper left breast area I did note a circle with suspected Chinese writing.

During an exam of the lower body pants pockets a wallet was located in a rear pants pocket. Inside the wallet were miscellaneous identifications to include a Washington State ID Card bearing the name of Benjamin S Oien.

Cpl Spiering took photographs of the deceased and proceeded to take measurements of the suspected impact point in relationship with the upper torso and lower body. Cpl Spiering also photographed the front left portion of the Train Engine and noted what appeared to be blood tissue spatter on the front and under carriage of the train engine.

On 05/16/2016, at approximately 0138 hours, Lilac City Body Transport (Reinhardt and Schwaube) arrived on scene. At approximately 0154 hours the deceased was bagged into a body bag and sealed with body tag #2213037.

At approximately 0215 the deceased was removed from the scene and the scene was released back to BNSF. I was informed by BNSF Officer Seymour that BNSF did have video mounted on the front of the train engine at the time of the accident. I requested video from BNSF.

I later attempted to identify the deceased's parents. I identified possible parents, Michael and Pamela Oien and a telephone number of 509-448-4897. This information was passed along to ME Investigator Jim Uttke.

At this time I will await the final autopsy report.
