Please be advised we received a call at 0733 from Steve Yost, BNSF, 817-342-2832, regarding a deceased person on tracks at between the crossings at 6<sup>th</sup> Street and SR 140 in Camas, Clark County. Train crew saw the body on the tracks but were unable to stop the train – unknown if person was deceased or not prior to train hitting. Body is now under the train. Local fire and police on the scene. No other information provided.
