Dear Darrick,

On November 2, 2016, the City of Walla Walla adopted an adjusted Solid Waste Rate Ordinance No. 2016-33 (attached) for 2017. The 2017 rates listed in the ordinance take effect for solid waste collection companies on February 1, 2017, or seventy-five days after a copy of this ordinance has been mailed as evidenced by the postmark on the notice, whichever occurs later.

RCW 70.95.212

Solid waste collection companies – notice of changes in tipping fees and disposal rate schedules.

To provide solid waste collection companies with sufficient time to prepare and submit tariffs and rate filings for public comment and commission approval, the owner or operator of a transfer station, landfill, or facility used to burn solid waste shall provide seventy-five days' notice to solid waste collection companies of any change in tipping fees and disposal rate schedules. The notice period shall begin on the date individual notice to a collection company is delivered to the company or is postmarked.

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ORDINANCE NO. <u>2016-33</u>

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING VARIOUS LANDFILL RATES, CHARGES, AND PENALTIES FOR THE CITY OF WALLA WALLA

WHEREAS, the City of Walla Walla was established in 1862 by an act of the Legislative Assembly of the Territory of Washington and passed Municipal Ordinance A-2405 on May 13, 1970 which classified the City of Walla Walla as a nonchartered code city under Title 35A of the Revised Code Washington (RCW); and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.21.150 authorizes the City to provide sanitation services in accordance with ch. 35.67 RCW; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.80.010 authorizes the City to provide utility services in accordance with ch. 35.92 RCW; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.67.020 authorizes the City to charge for provided sanitation (a/k/a refuse collection and disposal) services; and

WHEREAS, RCW 35.92.020 authorizes the City to charge for providing solid waste handling which includes recycling; and

WHEREAS, the Walla Walla City Council has determined that rate and charges addressed herein should be modified, and

WHEREAS, the Walla Walla City Council has considered adoption of this ordinance during a regularly and duly called public meeting of said Council, has given careful review and consideration to said ordinance, and finds said ordinance to be in the best interests of the City of Walla Walla,

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Walla Walla do ordain as follows:

Section 1: The following landfill rates, charges, credits, and penalties are hereby established and collectively referred to herein as rates. The 2017 rates listed below shall replace the existing rates listed below and shall take effect on February 1, 2017 in accordance with the Revised Code of Washington § 70.95.212:

^{*} Compost sales are charged according to a tiered rate schedule based on the amount of compost purchased in a calendar year. Customers are required to provide their receipts for previously purchased compost to the scale house Attendant when requesting a lower rate. As of January 1 of each year, charges revert to the basic rate per yard until the customer has purchased enough compost to qualify for a lower rate. The tiered rate schedule is as follows: Purchases of 10 yards or less are charged at the basic rate for 1 – 10 yards of compost. After 10 yards of compost are purchased, customers qualify for a reduced rate for purchase of yards 11 through 200. After 200 yards of compost have been purchased, customers qualify for a further reduced rate for purchase of yards 201 through 500. After purchasing 500 yards, customers qualify for a further reduced

rate. Please see the above rate schedule for the current and applicable rate for each tier.

Section 2: The Walla Walla City Council finds that the rates and charges established herein for City of Walla Walla, and Port of Walla Walla and other public agencies compensate for the true and full value of the services received by each customer in the applicable classification.

Section 3: This ordinance is referred to in the Walla Walla Municipal Code as the City's landfill rate ordinance.

Section 4: The rates and charges herein established are not exclusive and shall apply in addition to any other rates and charges which may apply.

Section 5: The City Clerk is authorized and directed to publish a summary hereof in accordance with Revised Code of Washington §§ 35A.13.200 and 35A.12.160 and give notice as required by Revised Code of Washington § 70.95.212.

Section 6: If any part of this ordinance is for any reason declared or held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such part shall be deemed a separate and distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining parts hereof.
