Dear Dumitrascu, Victor:

On April 11, 2017, Dumitrascu, Victor, d/b/a 2 Buff Guys Moving and Dump, filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) an application requesting authority to operate as a Household Goods Carriers carrier in the state of Washington.

On April 11, June 9, July 13, 2017, the Commission sent Dumitrascu, Victor notices describing the application requirements the company had not satisfied. Staff was also in contact with the applicant on many other separate occasions. Despite this notice, Dumitrascu, Victor has not met the following requirements as of the date of this letter: Did on provide three statements of support, and did not provide a Uniform Motor Carrier Certificate of Insurance (Form E) or Cargo Insurance (Form H.)

Accordingly, the application filed by Dumitrascu, Victor in TV-170247 for Household Goods Carriers authority is dismissed for failure to meet the application requirements.
