Dear Mr. Brown:

In July and August 2016, Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) staff provided technical assistance to Dlux Limos, LLC with respect to the licensing requirements for charter and excursion companies operating within the state of Washington. You submitted an application for charter authority, but did not file proof of liability insurance. It was staff's understanding that your bus was out of service for repairs and that you would complete your application, file proof of insurance and obtain charter authority before resuming operations.

Since then, Commission staff has written to you three times to provide additional technical assistance. On April 4, 2017 the Commission dismissed your application for failure to file proof of insurance along with your charter application.

Staff recently received information that Dlux Limos, LLC has been providing, and continues to provide passenger transportation services without Commission authority. Dlux Limos, LLC's Yelp profile lists more than ten customer reviews for transportation services provided since August 2016.

Operating as a party bus or charter company within Washington without the required certificate is illegal, is considered a gross misdemeanor, and is subject to a penalty of \$5,000 for each violation (occurrence).¹

To avoid immediate enforcement action by the Commission, by April 17, 2017 you must either cease and desist from providing any regulated transportation services, or submit a completed application, file proof of insurance and include the application fee.

EVENT SYNOPSIS

On 07/7/17 I, Austin Leno, was working on duty with Kelli Rimmer as a License and Standards Inspector to check compliance of SMC 6.310 and 6.320 in the City of Seattle. Rimmer and I were posing as passengers looking for a taxi in the Capitol Hill neighborhood. While standing outside of Quinn's Pub, we saw a party bus with no UTC markings pull up and unload a group of guys. I went to the back of the vehicle to look for markings and get the WA-plate BCM3805. Rimmer was standing near the door of the vehicle and started talking to me about needing a ride to Ballard as I walked back towards her. The driver called out to Rimmer, "Where you going"? Rimmer responded that we were going to the Tractor Tavern in Ballard. The driver said he could take us for \$40. He said he just ended his trip with the bachellor party that just unloaded. Rimmer and I agreed to the fare of \$40 and the ride. We entered the vehicle and worked out the location with the driver. The driver asked Rimmer to text him the address. The driver said his name was Michael and phone 206-687-6613. Rimmer text him the address and we proceeded to head west on Pike St. While in the vehicle, Rimmer and I saw many open containers of alcohol and beer. We took pictures of an open bottle of tequilla and beer cans. The driver said we could drink anything we found that was un-opened. There were un-opened beer cans, all alcohol bottles I saw were open. Upon arriving at the Tractor Tavern, I paid the agreed fare of \$40, added a \$5 tip and no change was needed. Inspector Tolley Sualoa and Donald Bolgiano were waiting as we exited and identified the driver. Inspector Sualoa sent a picture by text message from his phone to mine of WADL [REDACTED] - Michael Francis Brown. Rimmer and I confirmed that was our driver. Bolgiano as sent picture by text message of the vehicle with no markings for UTC.



Leno and Rimmer were undercover posing as passengers in Capitol Hill near Neumo's (925 E Pike St.), with directions to take a compliance ride to Tractor (5213 Ballard Ave NW). Inspector Bolgiano and I were positioned at Tractor Tavern to make contact and identify the driver in the event that Leno and Rimmer took a compliance ride. At 11:16PM, I received a series of text messages from Austin Leno that said "bcm3805 party bus from Neumos to Tractor tavern", "\$40", "Alcohol and open containers visible", "2066876613 driver's number" and "Name Michael". Based on my experience in this position, I interpreted these messages to mean Inspectors Leno and Rimmer were in a compliance ride in a party bus with license plate BCM3805, and were quoted a price of \$40. At approximately 11:36PM, I noticed a party bus

with WA license plate BCM3805 stop near Tractor Tavern on Ballard Ave NW. The party bus had no markings on the exterior of the bus aside from the WA plate and the word Champion on the rear. Party buses licensed through the UTC usually have identifying numbers on the driver and passenger side of the vehicle. But this vehicle had none. I saw Inspectors Leno and Rimmer exit the vehicle and I approached the vehicle, identified myself as an inspector and asked the driver to provide any paperwork to show the vehicle was licensed. The driver claimed the vehicle was licensed with the UTC, and showed me a list of documents on the screen of his smartphone. He did not know which one was the document. I gave him my business card and asked him to send the documentation to me by email instead. I asked for his WADL, and he provided WADL# [REDACTED] Michael Brown. While I was contacting the driver, Inspector Bolgiano took pictures of the vehicle, including the WA license plate.

DECLARATION

I, Donald Bolgiano, declare:

1. I am a Licenses and Standards Inspector employed by the City of Seattle Department of Finance and Administrative Services to enforce violations of Title V and Title VI of the Seattle Municipal Code and have worked in this position since 03/15/2015.

2. As a Licenses and Standards Inspector, I am responsible for inspecting and investigating businesses and commercial activities to determine compliance with laws and regulations pertaining to taxes, business licenses and weights & measures,


3. I am competent to testify and make this declaration based on my personal knowledge.

4. While on duty as a License and Standards Inspector on 07/07/2017 I was checking for compliance of SMC 6.310 & 6.320. At approximately 2316 Hrs I received a text message from Inspector Austin Leno. Inspector Leno provided a WA license plate, BCM3805, and stated that he and Inspector Kelli Rimmer had been solicited by the driver of a party bus. Inspector Leno stated that they had been quoted a price of \$40.00 from Neumo's (925 E. Pike St) to Tractor Tavern (5213 Ballard Ave NW). He noted that there were no transportation markings on the vehicle and numerous open containers of alcohol in the back of the vehicle. At approximately 2335 Hrs the Inspectors arrived at Tractor Tavern. Inspector Sualoa and I were waiting at the destination and made contact with the driver of the party bus. While Inspector Sualoa spoke with the driver I took pictures of the vehicle and its license plate. I noted that there were no UTC or US DOT numbers on the vehicle. Inspector Sualoa identified the driver of the vehicle as Michael Brown, WA PIC# [REDACTED] Mr. Brown stated that he had a UTC

license for the vehicle, but was unable to produce it. Inspector Sualoa told Mr. Brown to email him a copy of the paper work once he could and provided a business card with his contact information. As of 07/12/2017 no UTC paper work or other supporting documents have been received from Mr. Brown. Per WA DOL, the vehicle in question is currently registered as a Passenger vehicle.

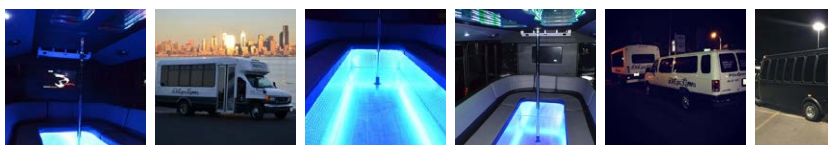
