Enclosed, please find revised pages, 2, 22, 23, 28, 33, 34, and 36 to the above-referenced tariff. These proposed revised tariff pages contain decreased rates for residential and commercial garbage collection services. The requested rate decrease is necessary to reflect the reduction in the disposal rate at the Spokane Waste to Energy facility. The City of Spokane approved the decrease in disposal fees from \$108.41 to \$104.50 per ton to become effective on January 1, 2018. The decreased rates, if approved by the commission, would approximately decrease Company revenue by \$4,800, and residential and commercial garbage rates by less than .1%. The effective date of these proposed tariff revisions is January 1, 2018.

Enclosed for your review are our accounting workpapers and a copy of the letter from the City of Spokane Solid Waste Disposal informing us of the decrease in disposal fees. As this filing requests a decrease in rates, we are submitting this filing in accordance with WAC 480-70-262. Upon approval by the Commission of this filing, affected customers will be notified of this rate decrease on their next regularly scheduled billing.
