RE: WAC 480-143-190 Property Disclosure Report

In accordance with WAC 480-143-190, Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, submits this report to the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. In 2017, PacifiCorp had one applicable transaction of transferred property that exceeded the reporting threshold required in the rule. Using rate base balances authorized by the Commission in Docket UE-152253, this threshold is \$81,394. Attachment A provides the accounting details of this transaction. Please note that only items allocated to Washington using the West Control Area inter-jurisdictional allocation methodology are considered in preparing this report.

Attachment B is an affidavit demonstrating that the items were not necessary or useful to perform Pacific Power's public duties.
