Thanks so much for the info. For some reason it never made it to me and the person who goes through our mail never saw it. Unfortunately it got misplaced somehow and I sincerely apologize. We also have had some circumstance that made it challenging as well. The owner has had some serious health issues where he has been absent for the last 4 to 5 weeks and that required 2 weeks in the hospital and he will be gone from work for another few weeks. Also, this hearing was my responsibility and my fault as I overlooked it due to the fact I was out of town for much of May as well as had the wrong date in my calendar (the 24<sup>th</sup>) for the hearing along with never seeing the letter for the details of time and location.

We would have loved to be at the meeting to give the reason for the violations and again apologize for not being there.

The good news now is that we are in compliance with the laws now in calling for locates on our projects prior to working on them. In the past we always delegated that to the General contractor and never realized they were not doing it as that was part of our bid to the contractor. We also were unaware of the specific law requirements where staking is considered digging and we had to call for locates ourselves. I know ignorance is no excuse and again we apologize for violating the dig laws.

We hope you understand the unique circumstances and did not purposely miss the hearing as we know the importance of complying with the law and taken responsibility.
