Attached for electronic filing with the Commission is the following tariff sheet proposed to be effective October 1, 2018:

Seventh Revision Sheet 192 Canceling Sixth Revision Sheet 192

The purpose of this filing is to increase the amount of total natural gas “Low Income Rate Assistance Rate Adjustment” (LIRAP) funding by 7 percent in compliance with Commission Order No. 05, in Docket UG-150205. By way of background, Order No. 05 required Avista to file revisions to Schedule 192 to increase LIRAP funding by 7 percent for the program year beginning October 1, 2016 with annual funding increases through the program year beginning October 1, 2019, by August 15th of each year. Also included in this filing is a true-up of the estimated revenues collected for LIRAP to the actual collections for the prior October to September program year. The true-up amount is a rebate balance of \$150,570.

The Company requests the Commission approve the proposed increase in rates and charges in Schedule 192 with an effective date of October 1, 2018. The estimated annual revenue change associated with this filing is an increase of approximately \$0.1 million, or an increase of 0.1% in overall billed rates. The proposed rate increase will have an average monthly bill impact to residential natural gas customers using 65 therms of \$0.03, or 0.06%. If approved, the average monthly bill would increase from \$50.66 to \$50.69.
