**Re:** Review Committee Decision - Case Number 18-063 Avista Corporation vs Roch Construction

Dear Mr. Johnson:

The Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee received a complaint regarding a potential violation of the Washington State Dig Law RCW 19.122.030(6)(a) for work performed on 6/4/2018.

On July 18, 2018 the Washington State Dig Law Safety Committee Review Board heard complaint Case 18-063 Avista Corporation vs Roch Construction.

The Review Committee determined that the respondent did not violate RCW 19.122.030(6)(a). The Committee found that the respondent did violate RCW 19.122.040(2) (a) for failing to use reasonable care to determine the precise location of facilities that have been marked.

The Review Committee recommends the following penalty be assessed to the respondent:

• \$1000.00 penalty for one violation of RCW 19.122.040(2)(a)

A penalty of \$1000.00 with \$800.00 deferred on the condition that the owner and field staff attend NUCA dig safe training and have no additional violation of RCW 19.122 within 12 months of receiving a penalty assessment order.
