Effective Date of January 1, 2019. Recycling and Disposal Services, Inc. has given notice that they are increasing our disposal fees by 6.7%, to a new rate of \$105.34 per ton beginning January 1, 2019. The requested increase affects all residential and commercial garbage service rates related to disposal. If approved by the Commission as filed, these requested rates would result increase company revenues by \$25,404, and residential and commercial rates

We are requesting an exemption for this submittal from the requirement to file work papers for a general rate proceeding as outlined in WAC 480-07-520(4), so that the tariff rates may be adjusted for the disposal fee increase only.

In accordance with WAC 480-70-271(2), affected customers will be notified on their next regularly scheduled billing after Commission approval.
