Pacific Power & Light Company (Pacific Power), a division of PacifiCorp, submits the following revised tariff sheets under RCW 80.28.050 and WAC chapter 480-80. The company requests an effective date of January 1, 2019.

Seventh Revision of Sheet No. 17.1    Schedule 17    Low Income Bill Assistance Program –  
Residential Service Optional for  
Qualifying Customers

Pacific Power submits a revised Tariff Sheet No. 17.1 to remove an outdated footnote. Under the company's previous Low Income Bill Assistance Program, customers were only eligible for a Low Income Energy Credit during the winter months of November through April. As part of the company's low income stakeholder collaborative coming out of the company's 2015 limited-issue rate filing, stakeholders agreed to certain changes to the Low Income Bill Assistance Program. One of the agreed upon changes was to apply the Low Income Energy Credit to all 12 months of the year. Pacific Power's Schedule 17 was amended on May 1, 2017, to reflect the expiration on October 31, 2017, of the limitation on the availability of the Low Income Energy Credit. Since October 31, 2017, the Low Income Energy Credit has been available during all 12 months of the year, rendering the footnote included on Tariff Sheet No. 17.1 unnecessary. The company is proposing to remove the footnote to avoid any potential confusion going forward.
