

**RESOLUTION NO. 2017 - 41**  
**RE: Rescinding Resolution 2014-20**  
**Disposal Charges for Dryden Transfer Station**

**WHEREAS**, the rates for the Dryden Transfer Station are in need of updating for all wastes to coincide with the increased cost of operations at the Dryden Transfer Station; and

**WHEREAS**, the used oil and antifreeze collection cost has increased, and the minimum brush disposal and chipping necessitates a minimum rate for recovering costs, as well as compost sales are no longer sold due to the halt of processing. The increase in rates shall provide the necessary means to continue the collection of used oil and antifreeze and provide the public with a safe site for recycling; and

**WHEREAS**, the minimum rate for brush and wood debris is established at 200 pounds for \$10.00. Used oil and antifreeze has increased from no fee to \$1.00 per gallon.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the following rates are increased as a result of operation costs at the transfer station and shall be exclusive of the Washington State refuse collection tax. The disposal fees at the Dryden Transfer Station shall be amended as follows and will become effective the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June, 2017; and
