Pursuant to RCW 70.95.212 please accept this letter as 75 day notification of disposal rate adjustment.

New disposal rates becoming **effective January 1, 2020**, are as follows:

1. A 2.9% increase for solid waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy facility. Disposal fee for solid waste at the Waste to Energy Facility is going from \$107.53 per ton to \$110.65 per ton. The minimum fee for solid waste is increasing from \$17.57 to \$18.08.
2. A 2.9% increase for clean green yard waste delivered to the Spokane Waste to Energy Facility. Disposal of clean green is going from \$54.23 per ton to \$55.80 per ton. The minimum fee for clean green is increasing from \$5.77 to \$5.94.
3. A 2.9% increase for waste delivered to the Waste to Energy Facility which the director determines requires special handling. Disposal fee for special handling waste is going from \$193.28 per ton to \$198.89 per ton. The minimum fee for waste requiring special handling is increasing from \$96.64 to \$99.44.
4. A 2.9% increase for waste tires delivered to the Waste to Energy Facility. Disposal fee is going from \$140.15 per ton to \$144.21 per ton. The minimum fee for waste tires is increasing from \$20.99 to \$21.60.
