Frontier Communications Northwest Inc. submits Advice No. 3361, a tariff filing in the General and Local Exchange Tariff, WN U-17, Section 3.

The purpose of this filing is to increase certain Residence and Business nonrecurring Service Charge rates.

Frontier requires revenue from regulated services such as nonrecurring service charges to maintain network equipment and facilities increasing costs.

Attached are the proposed tariff sheets containing the increased rates and the supporting Projected Annual Revenue Analysis, which includes the annual projected billing units, revenue and percentage increase for those changes. Confidential supporting projected annual revenue analysis, per WAC 480-07-160 and a redacted version, per WAC 480-07-160.

Customers are being notified 30 days prior to the Reconnect Charge rate increase. A copy of the bill message is included in this filing as Attachment B. Customers will be given a quote for the nonrecurring Service Order and Central Office Connection Charges at the time they order service.

Frontier requests an effective date of January 26, 2019 for this tariff filing.
