On, January 9, 2020, the committee formed a review board and heard Cases 19-096, filed by Austin's Lend-A-Hand against Snohomish PUD.

The review board determined that the respondent, Snohomish PUD, violated RCW 19.122.030(3)(a) for failing to mark their known facilities with reasonable accuracy and completeness.

Therefore, the committee recommends a total penalty of \$5000.00.
