Thank you for submitting engineering documents for the proposed high-capacity pump replacement project. The documents were prepared by your engineer, Greg Cane, PE and received in our office on December 13, 2018. There appears to be minimal changes from the report submitted in December 2016. Therefore, we are extending this approval another 2 years.

WAC 246-290-120(8) provides that if construction of the project has not been started within two years of the date of this letter, this approval will become null and void unless you take action at that time to arrange for an extension of the approval in the manner prescribed.

The design and construction documents for the above project were reviewed and, in accordance with the provisions of WAC 246-290 are APPROVED. Future revisions in the rules may be more stringent and require facility modifications or corrective action.

Design Summary: The existing propane-engine powered fire pumps will be replaced with two electric motor driven pumps (40hp). The new pumps will provide 515gpm at 182ft of head each. One of these pumps along with the existing domestic pumps can provide the design flow rate of 678gpm (maximum day demand and fire flow) to the system. These new pumps will start when the domestic pumps cannot maintain a minimum of 30psi in the distribution system. Please confirm this set point with the construction completion report. This project does not change the system's approved service capacity.

This water system has also petitioned to have a back-up power generator available for both domestic and fire flow supply. Based on this submittal, the generator details will be submitted later.

Contractor Ackermann:

- 1. Ackermann will alternate the existing booster pumps as well as have the normal lead lag functionality. Ackermann will use the existing pressure switches as the redundant operation to the transmitter in case of transmitter failure. There will be a PID loop operation running speed control of the lead pump. Since the three pumps are different, it may be necessary to create individual loops per pump.

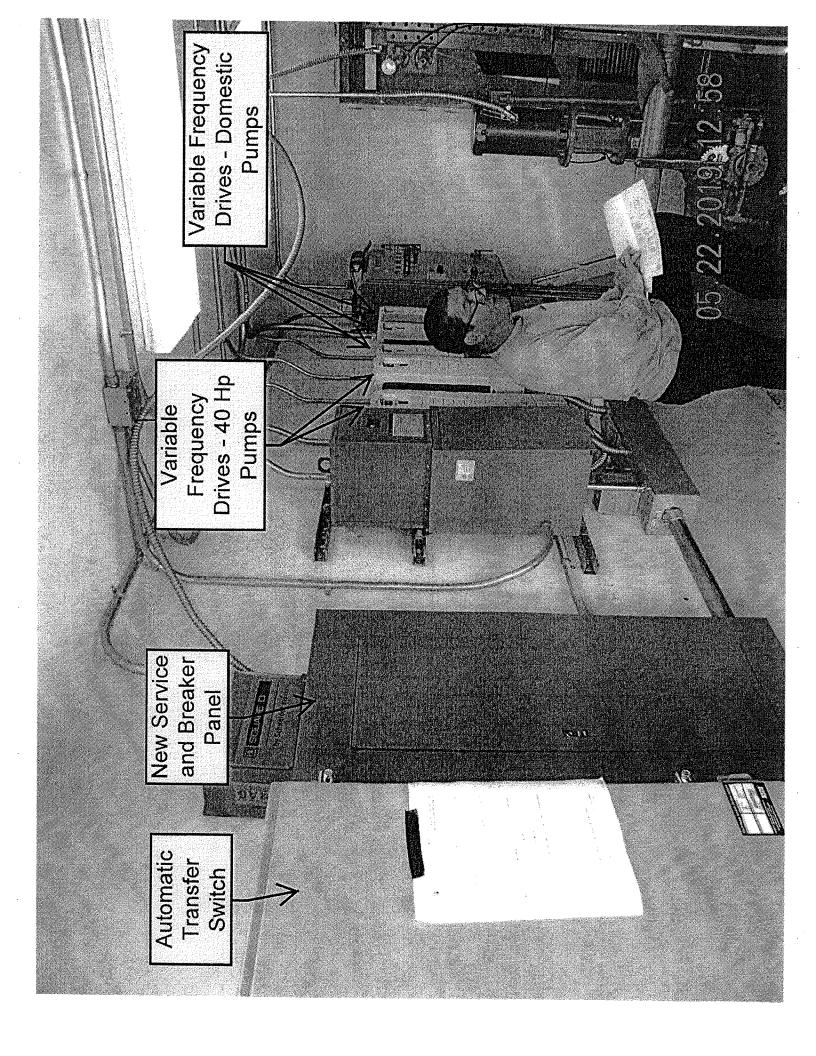

FOR VALUE RECEIVED, THUNDER RIDGE WATER CO., INC., a Washington corporation, promises to pay to the order of THUNDER RIDGE HOLDINGS, INC., a Washington corporation, the sum of ONE HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED EIGHTY FIVE AND 20/100 DOLLARS (\$150,385.20) with monthly compounded interest on the then balance from the 22nd day of March 2019 on unpaid principal at the rate of SIX PERCENT (6%) per annum; principal and interest payable in installments of TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED NINETY TWO AND 32/100 DOLLARS (\$2,492.32), or more, commencing on the first day of the month after surcharge becomes in effect, and continuing on the same day of each succeeding month until said principal and interest have been paid in full. If this note is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, Maker agrees to pay reasonable attorneys fees.

Thunder Ridge Water Co. Inc. has filed for approval from the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to include a surcharge for the installation of the new emergency electric pump and generator system. If approved, the new surcharge will be effective on March 15, 2020.

The new emergency backup system was required by the State Department of Health. The total cost of the project was \$214,836. The surcharge is for 70% of that amount (being \$150,385.20) to service the construction loan plus state taxes (excise & B&O). The remaining 30% was paid for by the Company.

There is no current surcharge. The proposed new monthly surcharge is \$17.74, to last for 60 months or sooner if paid off before. Customers have the option to pay a one-time payment sum of \$1,079.27 within 90 days of the effective date, thus saving interest costs. New hook-ups will pay the monthly surcharge upon first use of water. The current base rate of \$35.00 and the usage rates are not changed in this proposal.
