RE: Revised Commodity Credit, G-12 Tariff Number 4 for Rabanco Ltd (dba Republic Services of Lynnwood & Lynnwood Disposal).

Dear Mr. Johnson:

Please find attached revised tariff page revisions for G-12 tariff number 4 for Rabanco Ltd. (dba Republic Services of Lynnwood, Lynnwood Disposal).

This proposed change in the tariff reflects the change in the commodity credit for single family residential customers in the Service Areas defined in Appendices A and B from a credit of \$0.32 to a credit of \$0.09 and for multifamily customers, from a credit of \$0.14 to a credit of \$0.03 per yard. There is also changes in service rates to reflect an increase in WA Business & Occupation tax of 0.25% and residential yard waste disposal.

The other proposed change in tariff reflects a rate increase due to a 0.25% increase in Washington State B&O tax (effective April 2020) and an increase in residential yard waste disposal rate to \$65 per ton (effective September 2020). We are asking that this rate become effective on August 1, 2020.
