Re: Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc., G-58 YardWaste Disposal Cost Recovery Filing

On behalf of Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. G-58 I am filing certain revised tariff pages and other documents requesting a rate increase to be effective September 1, 2020. This filing is necessitated by a disposal cost increase at the Cedar Grove Composting Facility.

If this filing is approved by the Commission, the hauler's overall residential revenue will increase approximately 1.42%, or \$51,036. The revenue breakdown is:

This filing is for recovery of disposal fees pursuant to RCW 81.77.160. A copy of the letter of notification from Cedar Grove Composing Facility is included with the documents being filed.

Included with this filing is an Excel workbook titled Rubatino Yard Waste Disposal Fee Workbook .xlsx which is a disposal workbook previously furnished by staff. This workbook has rate calculations and tonnage taken from summarized billings from Cedar Grove. Please see Excel workbook 2020 Residential Yard Waste Tonnage.xlsx along with copies of Cedar Grove billings to Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc.

Revised tariff pages are included with this filing in an Excel workbook titled Rubatino Refuse Removal, Inc. Tariff No. 8, pages Checksheet and Item 100. If these rates are approved by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission they will become effective September 1, 2020. Affected customer will receive notice of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates under WAC 480-70-271(2)(a)(iii).

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The Company is requesting exemption from portions of WAC 480-07-520(4) - General rate proceedings-Solid Waste Collection Companies for this filing for recovery of disposal fees.
