RE: Tariff Submittal, Dump Fee Increase, Tariff Number 13, Columbia River Disposal, Inc., Certificate Number G-51.

Dear Mr. Johnson:

We respectfully request to update the rates under G-51 to reflect the increase in disposal fee from \$3.11 to \$5.00 per yard, a 61% increase, per yard. This increase reflects the current practice of disposing all solid waste collected within Klickitat County at the Dallesport Transfer Station in Klickitat County. This will increase revenue from residential customers by approximately \$600 (1.62%); commercial customers by \$900 (2.19%); and drop box customers by \$2,100 (.85%) for a 12-month period. There are approximately 2,000 residential, 300 commercial, and 15 drop box customers affected by this change.


The last general rate increase for G-51 became effective April 1, 2018.

Attached are revised pages as well as supporting documentation to justify this increase.

Pursuant to WAC 480-70-271(2) (iii), affected customers will receive notification of the change on the first billing reflecting the revision to rates.
