IX. Comments
Event Summary:
On September 14, 2020, at approximately 16:37 a BNSF Railway Co. freight train fatally struck a trespasser on BNSF Railway Co. owned track. This accident occurred 175 yards north of the Stromberg Canyon highway-rail grade crossing. The police report, witness statements and train video all indicate that the victim was walking southbound on the railroad tracks while wearing headphones and holding a cell phone. When the train conductor spotted the female on the tracks he immediately began braking and sounding the horn to alert the female. The train was unable to stop and struck the female from behind. A cell phone and headphones were found at the accident site. Witness statements indicated that the victim frequently walked on the tracks to meet friends. Two days prior to this incident a police officer reported stopping her and a friend out walking on the tracks and warned them that they were trespassing and they needed to get off the tracks. Law enforcement determined this fatality to be an accident on the part of the victim and the case was closed.
Site Description:
The accident site is in a rural location four miles north of Leavenworth, Washington. The accident happened 175 yards north of the Stromberg Canyon highway-rail grade crossing at milepost 16:75 on the BNSF Scenic Subdivision. The Stromberg Canyon highway-rail grade crossing, USDOT number 084494D south of the incident site is equipped with gate arms, flashing lights, and an audible bell. Chumstick Highway parallels the tracks less than 150 feet away. This location has one single main track. Looking north toward the direction of the oncoming train there is approximately 1500 feet of sight distance before the right hand curve.
Inspector Recommendations:
No recommendations as this appears to be an accident and isolated incident as the victim was walking on the tracks while using headphones.



NARRATIVE: On Monday, 09/14/20, at aprx 1635 hours, I was on-duty in investigations when I learned of a train pedestrian accident near Spromberg Canyon and the BNSF train tracks. Myself and CCSO DET Mathena responded. We arrived at aprx 1715 hours. DET Mathena took photos and I took measurements. The unknown deceased female had been walking on the edge of the rails, but on the ties, SB from Sunitsch Canyon area. She had apparently been wearing headphones as a pair of over the hear headphones had been found near the point of impact. BNSF INV Loren Barger spray painted the point of impact on the tracks and the point where she ended up on railroad embankment. I painted red marks on Chumstick shoulder that aligned with the point of impact and where her body lay on the embankment.

The point of impact was aprx 175 yards north of Spromberg crossing. Her body was thrown 22 feet south from point of impact, and it rolled 22 feet east, down the embankment, toward Chumstick. In comparison to other train deaths I had been to, the exterior trauma to her body appeared minimal, possibly indicating the train was not moving quickly. Coroner Earl Crowe arrived on scene and removed the body after our scene investigation. Non-photo ID in the victim's purse/wallet, indicated she may be a Carmen Twombly. Coroner Crowe was able to positively ID her Carmen Twombly on the following day, 09/15/20. Coroner Crowe stated she had a broken right arm, a broken neck, and massive head trauma. A clear baggie with a crystal substance which appeared to be methamphetamine was found in her bra. I booked this into evidence. I had also seen a blue plastic snort straw in her purse with white residue, a common ingestion method for methamphetamine. On Tuesday, 09/15/20, at aprx 0900 hours, I met with Dan Gough. He stated he lives just north of the accident location on Chumstick. He has lived there for many years and sees the trains coming by daily at all different speeds. On 09/14/20 at aprx 1630 hours, Dan stated he saw a woman walking SB on the tracks, from the Sunitsch Canyon area, toward his house. She was wearing a light blue top, had dirty blonde hair, wore headphones, was dancing and waving her arms in the air. Dan could see her coming from aprx 1/4 mile away out of the north, and he watched her walk SB past his house for at least 100 yards. Dan stated he then saw the train coming at a slow speed, possibly 25 to 35 mph. As the train went

past he heard the loud whistle 2 times and then heard the emergency braking. Dan got in his vehicle and drove SB, and then saw the body of the victim on the embankment.

On Thursday, 09/17/20, at aprx 1200 hours, myself and DET Mathena contacted Kathy Epperley at 14395 Chumstick. 1 week before the accident, Carmen had been parked in a vehicle at/on the tracks at the Spromberg crossing, which is just south of where she was struck. A neighbor tried to contact her to move away from the tracks or off the road, but she was crying and would not respond. Deputies contacted her, ID'd her, and got her to move along. The car was associated with 14395 Chumstick, the Epperley residence. Kathy was the only person home this day. She stated her son Scott Epperley knew Carmen and had brought her for Thanksgiving 2019. She had last been over at Kathy's house aprx 2 weeks before the accident. She had stayed here some, but was not living here. Kathy did not have contact info for her son Scott. Kathy stated her boyfriend was a Robert Blake of Leavenworth who lived in the Lake Wenatchee area. I called Robert Blake using his numbers in Spillman, neither of which are good numbers. On Thursday, 09/17/20, at aprx 1300 hours, we contacted Nicole Burnell of 11689 Sunitsch Canyon. Nichole, her husband James, and property owner Dave Lundin operate a camp for persons needing help at this location. Nicole stated Carmen was camped here, she pointed out an RV Carmen was camped in that is owned by Lundin. Nichole stated Carmen's family had already been to this location and had picked up all of her belongings. Nichole stated Carmen had lived here for about 2 weeks. Carmen had confessed to being a meth addict, and stated she was getting clean. Nichole talked to Carmen just before the accident. Carmen told Nichole she was walking to town to meet a friend. Nichole stated Carmen walked the tracks almost every day because it takes 15 minutes off walking Chumstick. Nichole was in a good mood and did not seem suicidal. Nichole was wearing over the ear headphones which she called BEATS, even though they were actually from Sony. Nichole stated Carmen's boyfriend was a Robert Blake, but the man she wanted to be with was a Levi Levitt. Nichole stated Carmen's dad had made contact with her just recently and inquired about living here also, he was set to move here within one week.

On Thursday, 09/17/20, at aprx 1600 hours, I called Levi Levitt on the phone. He last saw and spoke to Carmen 3 to 4 months ago. Everything was fine then. Levi was not aware of whom Carmen was dating now. Levi knew of Robert Blake but had no info about him.

On Thursday, 09/17/20, at aprx 1630 hours, CCSO DEP Mcleod informed me that on 09/12/20 at 1800 hours, he saw Carmen walking on the tracks, SB at Freund Canyon, with an unknown make subject. He stopped and told them to get off the tracks, that they were trespassing. Carmen walked away from Mcleod and onto Freund Canyon. The male came towards Mcleod and asked why it was trespassing. According to Mcleod, the male could have been Robert Blake or Levi Levitt, he didn't get close enough to ID him.

On Thursday, 09/17/20, at 1700 hours, myself and DEP Mcleod contacted Ryan Monesmith at MP2 Chumstick, he had just been walking on the tracks. Mcleod ID'd Ryan as the man Carmen had been walking on the tracks with on 09/12/20. Ryan told me he has been staying at a house at MP2 Chumstick while Carmen has been staying at Sunitsch Canyon. Ryan stated they are close friends, but just friends. They walk to town together almost every day on the tracks. Ryan stated on the day of the accident, 09/14/20, at aprx 1630 hours, he was talking on the with Carmen. Carmen stated she was walking on the tracks to meet him and would be there in 5 minutes. Ryan stated she never arrived. Carmen had 2 cellphones, 1 was near the point of impact and the other was closer to her body. Both had shattered screens. Ryan's story does seem believable and may be documented by the 2 cellphones both being out.

Report submitted by Detective Joshua Mathena #1136

On 09/14/2020 @ 1635 hours RiverCOM reported a train versus pedestrian accident near Chumstick Hwy and Spromberg Canyon in Leavenworth. I was currently working the north area of Chelan County and Sgt Long requested I respond to assist. While enroute, RiverCOM advised law enforcement was on scene and the person struck by the train was deceased. No other information was provided at this

time.

I arrived at 1726 hours and spoke with Corporal Mathena. I was told all employees on the train had been identified and initial photos were taken. Corporal Mathena had spoken with the train conductor and obtained an initial statement.

It was said the female victim had been walking s/b on the train tracks. The female was outside of the rails but still on the wood portion of the tracks. The train was traveling s/b as well and the conductor spotted the female. The conductor began breaking and sounding the horn to alert the female. It was said it appeared the female was possibly dancing while walking and never saw the train behind her. The train was unable to stop and soon struck the female. The train traveled a short distance down the tracks before coming to a full stop.

I next walked down the side road to where the victim had come to rest. I saw the area was secured with crime scene tape and the victim was covered with a blanket. I entered the scene and found what appeared to be the victim's personal items scattered about. I was able to locate headphones near the tracks. From the investigation, it is believed the victim was likely wearing headphones and listening to music at the time of the accident. Before moving any items, I photographed the entire scene.

From the scene we were able to determine the approximate area where the victim had been struck by the train. This was determined by one of the victim's shoes at this location. After being struck, the victim as thrown 22 feet down the tracks. The victim landed just below the tracks and at this location we located scattered blood evidence. The victim next rolled down the embankment 22 feet where she came to rest.

After a short time, Chief Deputy Coroner Earl Crowe arrived on scene and assisted with examining and removing the victim's body. Before the victim was moved, the blanket was removed and I photographed the victim as she lay. Once the scene and victim were fully documented, the victim was removed from the scene and Crowe took possession of the body and personal property pending a medical examination and identifying the victim. Non-photo identification was found with the victim and a positive ID could not be made at the scene. On 09/15/2020 I received a call from Crowe. I was told the victim had been identified as Carmen Jane Twombly DOB 06/29/1993. I was also told during the examination of Carmen's person, a baggie was suspected methamphetamine was located concealed in her bra. I would later have a chance to view this baggie

and agreed the substance inside was likely methamphetamine. The suspected methamphetamine was not tested but secured in CCSO evidence for destruction. Having Carmen identified I checked her in our local law enforcement database. I found a limited number of law enforcement contacts with Carmen dating back to 2017. In 2020, Carmen seemed to be contacted more frequently. She was the subject of three (3) separate welfare checks, the last on 09/07/2020. On 05/06/2020, a reporting party called in and reported Carmen was suicidal and was requesting law enforcement assistance. It was said in the call Carmen was scared, confused and hearing voices. The reporting party was able to drive Carmen to Cascade Medical Center where she eventually ran from because she was scared. It was noted in the call Carmen had been contacted and refused any medical assistance.

On 09/17/2020 Sgt Long and I contacted a residence located off of Chumstick Hwy. We were able to determine Carmen had been living at this location and we obtained a statement from one of the renters on site. See Sgt Long's report for further.

Case Status: This was determined to be an accident, closed with a report. DISTRIBUTION:

On 10/06/2020 @ 1100 hours, Sgt Long and I met with Officer Barger at the BNSF office located off S Columbia St in Wenatchee. The purpose of the meeting was to review the video from the train where Carmen had be struck.

Sgt Long and I viewed the short video three (3) times. We found the original statements obtained from the witnesses were consistent with the video. Carmen is seen walking on the wood portion of the tracks, just outside the rails. Carmen is walking on the left side and has her arms up and out. It appeared

Carmen was wearing headphones and had a cell phone in her right hand. You can clearly hear the train's horn being sounded in a desperate attempt to alert Carmen to the oncoming danger. It was clear from the video Carmen never turned around or acknowledge the oncoming train.

Before the impact, Carmen is out of frame and you do not see the actual accident.

Case Status: Closed, this incident is deemed an accident on Carmen's part. **DISTRIBUTION:**
