Dear Hazardous Waste Billing Partners:

Thank you for your ongoing work to collect and forward Hazardous Waste fees from the residents and businesses you serve, as required by King County Board of Health Code 11.04.

I am writing to remind you about the annual rate change in Hazardous Waste fees beginning January 1, 2020.

In 2018, the Board of Health approved a multi-year adjustment to Hazardous Waste fees, with fees increasing 5.4 percent annually from 2019 through 2022. This adjustment was needed to address cumulative impacts of inflation since the last rate increase in 2012. The rate schedule is shown in the table below.
