## IMPORTANT NOTICE \*UPDATED\*

April 7, 2021

Tatoosh Water Company has asked the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission to approve an application to increase rates and implement a 30-month surcharge. If approved, the new rates and surcharge will become effective June 1, 2021. If approved the rate increase would generate approximately an additional \$3,600 in monthly revenue to cover expenses, and the surcharge will generate a total of \$142,320 for a mandatory capital project.

The water rate increase will help cover increased expenses such as contract operations, repairs, maintenance, and insurance. The current rates were set in 2017 and do not cover current expenses. Expense deficits have been paid for by the owners of Tatoosh Water Company.

Usage rates are per 100 cf. One cubic foot=approx.7.48 gallons.

The system surcharge will replace two aging Pressure Reducing Valve (PRV) vaults. PRV vaults hold pipes and valves to reduce high pressure to low pressure to maintain high standards of water quality and quantity. The current PRV vaults have wear and age, and it is necessary they be replaced. The funds generated by this surcharge will pay for 100% of the completed project.

The surcharge is to expire November 1, 2023, or upon recovery of \$142,320. Cost includes engineering, construction and WA State sales tax. The Surcharge may be paid (within 90 days of effective date) in a one-time payment of \$995.25.
