ORDER 01

CANCELLING COMMERCIAL
FERRY CERTIFICATE

1 Hat Island Community Association (Hat Island or the Company) holds certificate BC-000096, for authority to provide commercial ferry service as described in the certificate.

2 On April 27, 2021, the Company filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a letter requesting voluntary cancellation of their certificate of public convenience and necessity as it does “not serve the general public.” Hat Island is a private community that only serves its owners and invited guests.

DISCUSSION

3 There are no rules or statutes that prohibit commercial ferry companies from voluntarily cancelling their certificates. Accordingly, the Company’s certificate is cancelled effective immediately.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS:


4 (1) That certificate BC-000096, held by Hat Island Community Association, is cancelled at the carrier’s request.

6 (2) The Company must cease all operations associated with certificate BC-000096.

7 The Commissioners, having determined this Order to be consistent with the public interest, directed the Secretary to enter this Order.
