You are commanded to appear before the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission at the special proceeding referenced in the attached Order and Notice of Hearing at 10 a.m. on February 2, 2022, and to remain there until discharged by the Commission, to give testimony and evidence under oath as to the operations of J&I Enterprises, Inc., d/b/a JDog Junk Removal. Iulian Bodas, Jessico Bodas, or a representative, shall appear virtually at the time and date listed above unless the Executive Director and Secretary of the Commission, by separate notice, specifies a different date and time. This is ordered pursuant to the subpoena powers granted in RCW 34.05.446, RCW 80.01.060(1) and RCW 81.04.510.

## You are further commanded to bring with you the following documents:

For a company seeking to avoid further enforcement action by ceasing unpermitted operations and leaving the industry, you must bring sufficient documentation or records to demonstrate closure of your unpermitted solid waste transportation business. In the case of those whose entire business involves solid waste transportation, those papers might include documentation from (1) the Secretary of State's office for dissolution of your business; (2) the Department of Revenue for cancellation of your business license; (3) your Internet service provider (or equivalent) showing cancellation of a website or email account; (4) your telephone provider showing cancellation of your corporate telephone number; (5) proof of cancellation of your company advertising; and (6) sales receipts for any company equipment sold in the process of shutting down and closing. For those companies who will continue with a business but only close that portion involving solid waste transportation, similar documentation (e.g., approved application for common carrier permit, changed website or advertising) will prove most helpful to the presiding officer.
